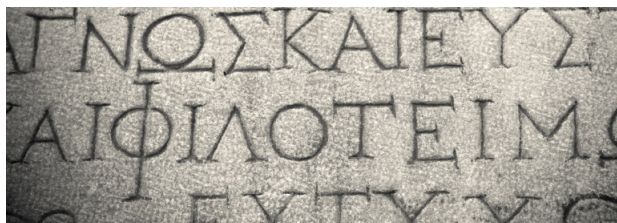
Polishing Your New Testament Greek Reading
