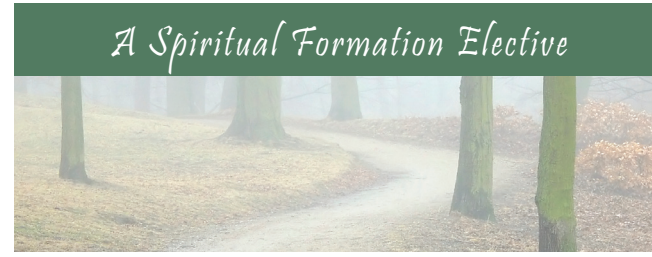

The Rev. Timothy C. Geoffrion, Ph.D. is the Co-Founder and President of Faith, Hope and Love Global Ministries, which can be found at [www.fhlglobal.org](http://www.fhlglobal.org).

As a teaching minister and spiritual life coach

on four different continents, Tim works with pastors, leaders, seminarians and other motivated individuals to help them to go deeper spiritually and to serve Christ more effectively in their particular callings. His ministry has taken him to such diverse places as Myanmar (Burma); the Democratic Republic of Congo; Chartres, France; and, most recently, Princeton Theological Seminary. He has developed special tools for personal and professional growth, and teaches frequently on spiritual vitality for life and leadership.

Tim is an ordained minister, with a doctorate in New Testament Studies. He has served as a church pastor; a college and seminary professor; and as the Executive Director and President of Family Hope Services/TreeHouse in Plymouth, Minnesota, a Christian-based nonprofit agency.

Tim's most recent publications include *The Spirit-Led Leader: Nine Leadership Practices and Soul Principles* (Alban, 2005) and *One Step at a Time: A Pilgrim's Guide to Spirit-Led Living* (Alban, 2008).



## ABOUT SPIRIT~LED LIVING: THE WAY FORWARD

This course offers an opportunity for spiritual renewal, including guidance on how to know God better and experience greater personal transformation. Tim Geoffrion will be drawing on his five-hundred mile pilgrimage across northern Spain, his most recent book, *One Step at a Time: A Pilgrim's Guide to Spirit-Led Living* (Alban, 2008), and special tools he has designed to help Christians create and pursue vision for every aspect of their lives.

At the heart of this course is a conviction that the key to spiritual vitality and growth is the work of the Holy Spirit, who draws us to God, reveals what we need to see in our life and circumstances, leads us in the ways God wants us to go, and empowers us to fulfill God's purposes for our life. Spiritual renewal, then, is about reconnecting to God's Spirit, so that we may experience refreshment for souls and renewed inspiration and encouragement to press on with our spiritual pilgrimage in Christ's service. Special consideration will be given to helping others to grow spiritually, too.
