FLEXIBLE, FAITH-FOCUSED SEMINARY PROGRAMS

Pittsburgh Theological Seminary offers the master of divinity (M.Div.), master of theological studies, master of arts in pastoral studies, and doctor of ministry programs, as well as an array of certificate programs—all focused on building professional skills to live your calling.

Our hybrid master's degree program format allows students to take a combination of in-person and online courses that provide the space, time, and flexibility for students to continue managing life's responsibilities while earning their seminary degree.

Classes start in the fall and sprint semesters with additional summer and January terms.

WHY PITTSBURGH THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY?

Through our hybrid degree and certificate programs, Pittsburgh Theological Seminary ensures our student community learns, grows, and flourishes on a path to practical ministry. Our student prepare to engage in God's work with parishes, nonprofits, and institutions specific to their call, including ordination.

The 6:1 student-to-faculty ratio encourages interaction and facilitates mentoring relationships in our community of scholars who serve the church.

An education at Pittsburgh Seminary is affordable. PTS invests in our students. 82 percent of the 2021-2022 master's graduating class did not borrow loans at all while attending PTS.

In our student body, we draw on the best of our tradition and learn from others as the Spirit shapes and reshapes our common life and work.

Pittsburgh is home to 90 unique cultural neighborhoods. Within a short drive from campus, students can serve in urban, suburban, and rural ministry contexts.

PTS prepares people for ministries familiar and yet to unfold and communities present and yet to be gathered.

WHO STUDIES AT PITTSBURGH THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY?

Our students are often working full time, raising families, and serving churches. Some are in non-church-related careers intending to pursue a church vocation, and others are serving congregations ats pastors and educators who have not yet earned a seminary degree.

Other students are active church members interested in serious theological student but do not intend to pursue ordained or licensed ministry. Not all students expect to earn a degree. Taking classes for personal enrichment is a wonderful opportunity to apply to our seminary certificate programs.
