- It is where faculty and staff bring theological traditions and theories to bear upon the practices of ministry for the sake of the church and the world.



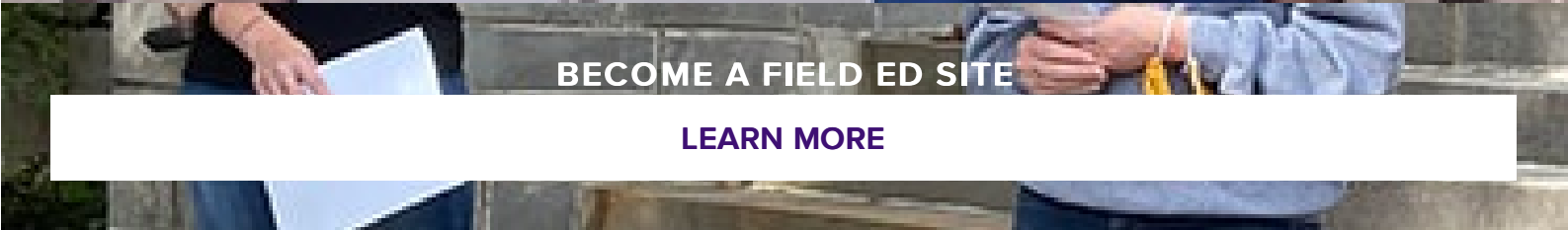
