
The Seminary remains without power. The campus is closed, and classes are canceled for Wednesday. Be safe!



# **CELEBRATING THE CLASS OF 2025**

Pittsburgh Theological Seminary will celebrate the Class of 2025 during its 229<sup>th</sup> commencement May 30 at 4:00 p.m. at East Liberty Presbyterian Church. During the service, the Rev. Jihyun Oh, executive director and stated clerk of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), will address the graduates.

The commencement service will be livestreamed here and on the Seminary's Facebook page.

Oh is the first Korean American to serve in the denomination's highest office, only the second woman, and the first woman of

color elected to lead the PC(USA) in its more than 300year history in the U.S. For five years, she served as director of Mid Council Ministries in the Office of the General Assembly and was manager of call process support before that. Ordained as a teaching elder by the Presbytery of Tropical Florida on behalf of the Presbytery of Chicago, Oh has served in several pastoral roles as well as hospital chaplain. She is currently a member of the Presbytery of Greater Atlanta.
