Pittsburgh Theological Seminary's Master of Divinity (M.Div.) hybrid degree is a professional program that prepares individuals for ordained ministry and general pastoral and religious leadership in congregations and other settings. Our flexible M.Div. program can be taken on a full-time or part-time schedule through day or evening courses. Hybrid courses meet synchronously each week and in-person twice per semester.

Our Master of Divinity coursework offers deep integration between classical theological disciplines and the missional nature of ministry. Throughout this seminary degree program, we encourage students to engage in deep theological reflection that considers historical and current contexts.

The hybrid program provides opportunities and tools for vocational discernment and nurtures spiritual formation in the Christian tradition-both on campus and in your neighborhood.

Students in the Master of Divinity (M.Div.) program benefit from contextual learning through Field Education and a required cross-cultural experience. During the year-long Field Ed course and ministry placement, students integrate coursework and firsthand experience with the Church's mission in the world at hospitals, nonprofits, special agencies, and churches in urban, suburban, and rural locations.

The January and Summer Terms offer M.Div. students the flexibility to explore electives, deepen their writing skills, learn more about their own faith tradition and others, plus experience a cross-cultural mission trip. These transformative experiences throughout the seminary degree include two classes in spiritual formation the first year, two semesters of field education during the second year, and up to six electives as a senior.

## **ABOUT THE M.DIV. PROGRAM**

Our hybrid M.Div. program can be taken either part or full time with day and evening classes available. Course are hybrid and students can customize their program with in-person and online classes.

A low student-to-faculty ratio enables close interaction with dedicated scholars and teachers, encouraging and mentoring students on their journey to a career in Christian ministry.

With the largest theological library in the tri-state area, Pittsburgh Theological Seminary offers unmatched resources for students to research and explore a variety of theological topics.
